Anaheim's Economic and Tax-Generating Engine

The Anaheim Resort District is the city's economic engine — generating 50% of the tax revenue on only 5% of the land.

This year alone, hotels have collected a record \$90 million in bed tax revenue (TOT) from overnight visitors. That tax revenue goes directly to the city's General Fund, which helps pay for vital services like police and fire protection.

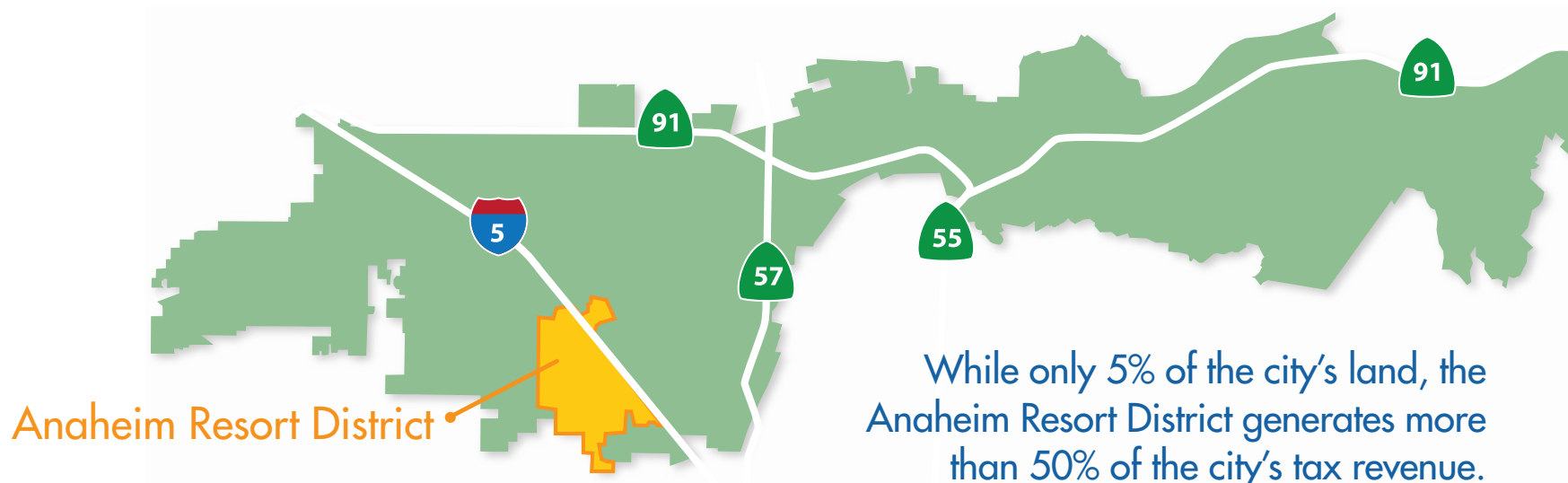
In fact, the TOT is the single largest source of General Fund revenue for Anaheim and is 10-times greater than any other city in Orange County.

Delivering Important Benefits to Anaheim Residents and Neighborhoods

Anaheim residents and neighborhoods are the biggest beneficiary of tax revenue generated by the visitors to the Resort District.

The bed tax (TOT) supports vital neighborhood programs like public safety, street improvements, libraries, parks, and graffiti abatement.

This year's record breaking \$90 million in TOT revenue has never been more important to strengthening neighborhoods and enhancing the overall quality of life in Anaheim.
